steps to planning a meetup

step 1: set up a poll on discord to gauge interest purpose: check if members are interested in your idea!

- open discord and navigate to the relevant channel (e.g. #chicago, #running)
- create a poll for the meetup, like "who's interested in a queer movie night?"
- leave the poll open for 24-48 hours

step 2: create an event in discord

purpose: make it official and let members RSVP.

- log in to <u>discord</u> and go to the **events** section.
- click create event and fill out the details:
 - add event name, details, date, time, and location.
- **publish** the event!

step 3: track RSVPs on partiful optional

purpose: tool to keep track of attendees for IRL events, including folks not in our discord.

- log in to **<u>partiful</u>** and set up your **event**:
 - $\circ\;\;$ add event name, details, date, time, and location.
- share the rsvp link in the appropriate discord channels and externally.
